1. Mr. & Mrs. Tung Chao Chang Memorial Scholarship: endowment from Mr. Nanting Chang in memory of his parents, Mr. & Mrs. Tung Chao Chang, \$2,000 each for five students

2. Mr. Sweet Huat Ling Memorial Scholarship: endowment from Mr. William Ling in memory of his father, Mr. Sweet Huat Ling, \$3,000 for one student

3. Mrs. Kun Ling Memorial Scholarship: endowment from Mrs. Celia Lin in memory of her mother, Mrs. Kun Ling, \$2,000 for one student

4. Mr. & Mrs. Tsair-Shing Wang Memorial Scholarship: endowment from Mrs. Mellisa Jung in memory of her parents, Mr. & Mrs. Tsair-Shing Wang, \$1,000 for one student

Senior students who are currently enrolled in the Greater Houston Area high schools, plan to pursue college education, and can demonstrate financial needs are eligible to apply. All applications will be evaluated based on financial needs, academic achievement, leadership, community service, and extracurricular activities.

Qualified applicants should submit complete documentation postmarked no later than **February 29, 2020**.

Qualifications:

1. College-bound senior students currently enrolled in the Greater Houston Area high schools;
2. High school GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale;
3. SAT score of at least 1050 on a 1600 scale, or ACT score of at least 20;
4. Can demonstrate financial needs.

Required Documents:

1. A completed Application Form, available at <http://www.jccaa.net>;
2. A copy of high school transcript;
3. A copy of SAT or ACT score report;
4. An essay in English of 500 words or less that includes a brief biography, family description, reasons for financial needs, thoughts on the applicant's future plans and goals, and any topic that the applicant feels would be of consideration to the selection committee. The essay must be typed, double-spaced, and on letter size paper;
5. Two letters of recommendation directly mailed to the JCCAA Scholarship Committee, one of which must be from a high school teacher or counselor. The letter should indicate class ranking and percentile, if not shown in transcript;
6. A copy of Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) of Federal Student Aid Program. FAFSA can be applied free on www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Certain qualified candidate(s) will be notified for interview to verify the financial needs. *JCCAA reserves the right to disqualify applicants who provide fraudulent information.*

Scholarship recipients will be notified by JCCAA in April/May, 2020. *The Scholarship Award Ceremony will be held at the JCCAA annual banquet in June, 2020.*
