2021 JCCAA Leadership and Community Service Scholarship

Announcement

For the academic year 2021, JCCAA will provide a Leadership and Community Service Scholarship. This scholarship is to be awarded to up to two students, who graduated from high school or college in Taiwan and are currently enrolled in an undergraduate or a graduate program at an accredited college or university in the Greater Houston Area. Each student will receive \$2000 scholarship award. JCCAA encourages qualified students with outstanding achievements in leadership and community service to apply.

Qualifications – Students who:

- Graduated from high school or college in Taiwan, and are currently enrolled in an undergraduate or a graduate program at an accredited college or university in the Greater Houston Area
- Meet the following academic requirements: GPA of 3.0 and higher
- Have outstanding achievement(s) in **Leadership and Community Service**
- Have never previously received the JCCAA Leadership and Community Services Scholarship

Required Documents

- A completed Application Form, available at www.jccaa.net
- A transcript covering all of his/her thus completed undergraduate and graduate work
- Two letters of recommendation directly submitted to the JCCAA Scholarship Committee at fcheng49@yahoo.com *Emphasis on candidate's **leadership and community service** is encouraged.
- An essay with a maximum of 500 with any topic the applicant deems appropriate for the Scholarship Committee to consider
- A resume with a maximum of two pages listing any leadership positions held, community services rendered, and any other major achievements *Attach the applicable certificates and/or awards as supplemental documents.

Qualified candidate(s) may be notified for interview.

The information submitted must be accurate. *JCCAA reserves the right to disqualify applicants who provide fraudulent information.* All documents submitted will not be returned to applicants and will be kept strictly confidential by the JCCAA Scholarship Committee.

Timeline:

- The scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by JCCAA in April/May 2021.
- A scholarship award ceremony will take place at JCCAA's annual banquet to be held in June 2021.
