2021 Ling Family Scholarship in Memory of Mrs. Sophia Siu-Ho Yang Liu

Announcement

For the academic year 2021, JCCAA will provide a need-based scholarship with an endowment from **Mrs. Lily Ling in memory of her mother, Mrs. Sophia Siu-Ho Yang Liu**. This scholarship, in the amount of \$3,000, is to be awarded to one Northbrook high school senior student. The JCCAA Scholarship Committee will process the application, selection, and award of the scholarship. Senior students, who are currently enrolled in Northbrook High School, plan to pursue a college education, and can demonstrate financial needs are eligible to apply.

Qualifications:

1. College-bound senior students currently enrolled in Northbrook High School
2. High school GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
3. SAT score of at least 1050 on scale of 1600, or ACT score of at least 20
4. Can demonstrate financial needs

Required Documents:

1. A completed Application Form, available at www.jccaa.net
2. A copy of high school transcript
3. A copy of SAT or ACT score report
4. An English essay with a maximum of 500 words that includes a brief biography, family description, reasons for financial needs, thoughts on the applicant's future plans and goals, and any topic that the applicant feels would be of consideration to the selection committee
5. Two letters of recommendation directly submitted to the JCCAA Scholarship Committee at fcheng49@yahoo.com, one of which must be from a high school teacher or counselor
6. A copy of Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) of Federal Student Aid Program *FAFSA can be applied free on www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Certain qualified candidate(s) will be notified for interview to verify the financial needs.

All applications will be evaluated based on financial needs, academic achievement, leadership, community service, and extracurricular activities.

Timeline:

- **All** required documents must be submitted electronically to the JCCAA Scholarship Committee at fcheng49@yahoo.com no later than **February 28, 2021**.
- The scholarship recipient will be notified by JCCAA in April/May 2021.
- A scholarship award ceremony will take place at JCCAA's annual banquet to be held in June 2021.
