




1.1 How to get Zoom meeting on your TV screen

There are lots of options for getting Zoom on your TV, but they basically fall into two areas - wired or wireless. The advantage of wired is that it's a more stable connection (less to go wrong), the advantage of wireless is that you can keep the phone and camera close to you.

Use AirPlay with Apple TV or AirPlay-enabled TVs (wireless)

One of the easiest ways if you have an iPhone or iPad, is to use AirPlay and Apple TV box. This will let you mirror your display on your TV via Apple TV box. Mirroring is where a second screen shows what's on the first screen. Today, I introduce Apple TV box as wireless option.



How to get Zoom meeting on your TV screen, via Apple TV

Procedure to get Zoom on your TV using iPhone & "Apple TV box"

- 1. Make sure your iPhone is connected to the same Wi-Fi network as the Apple TV box, otherwise it won't work.
- 2. Pull down the Action Center from the top right of your iPhone.
- 3. Tap Screen Mirroring.

4. Tap the name of your Apple TV that appears in the list. Your TV screen will then mirror to your iPhone screen.

5. Open Zoom and make the call.

3 After click "Create Movie", you may rotate your iPhone horizontally.




Assemble your movies in the Timeline.


Play video in the Viewer.


- 4 To start editing in iMovie, tap a clip, shown in yellow on the timeline. Edit your clips in iMovie:
 - · Edit the length of a clip, change the beginning or end point
 - Turn one long clip into multiple short clips
 - Add background music to your clip
 - Set the Ken Burns effect to bring life to your photos via controlling zooming and panning
 - Slow down or speed up a clip, increase or decrease the audio on a clip
 - Change the transitions between clips
 - Add text in motion on the photo/video clip

Edit the length of a clip, turn one long clip into multiple short clips, change the beginning or end point.









